Memorandum

That on or about the Twenty fifth Day of August in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and ffive Andreas Roseing late Merchant of the Shiplinon in East Indies deceased being on Shoar at Callicut in Bengall in the East Indies and being sick of the sickness whereof he dyed did utter unruptate and declare his last Will and Testament unruptate or by word of mouth in these or the like words following vizt I give all that I have in the world to Peter Erasmus my Assignate he having been very kinde to me whith words or words to the same effect he uttered and spoke in the presence of severall credible witnesses with intent that the same should stand for and be his last Will and Testament and desired the persons then present to take notice of what he soe sayd and declared and the said deceased was at all and singular the premises of sound and perfect minde and memory Richard Grainger William Griffin

I Edward Rippington of the parish of Septford in the County of Kent Blacksmith being infirm weak and tiazzy in body but of perfect sound and disposing minde and memory (praise be therefore given to Almighty God for the same) and tulling to minde the many uncertainties of this transitory life and that all flesh must yeild unto death when it shall please God to call Doe for avoiding controversies after my decrease make publish and declare these presents to be and containe all my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say) first and principally I commend my soul into the hands

of Almighty God my Creator and Redeemer assuredly con-
 fiding and believing I shall have free pardon and remission of
 all my sinns and after this mortall life ended to enjoy eternall
 Rest and happyness in the Kingdome of Heavens And my Body I
 commit to the Earth to be decently interred at the discretion of
 my Executor herein after named And touching such temporall
 Estate as God of his infinite goodnes hath been pleased to
 bless me withall I give and dispose thereof in manner following
 (that is to say) I give and bequeath unto my brother
 Joseph Rippington I doo pence Item I give and bequeath unto
 my kinsman Joseph Rippington son of my said brother the summe
 of ten pounds current money of England Item I give and bequeath
 unto my servant maid Ann Griffith the summe of twenty pounds
 of like money Item I give and bequeath unto my said servant
 Ann Griffith two pair of sheets my wifes best Cowe and all
 her wearing sinnen and my best feather Bed and all the
 appurtenances therunto belonging as alsoe all the furniture
 of my best Chamber Item I give and bequeath unto my said kinsman
 Joseph Rippington all my wearing apparrell both sinnen and woollen
 All the Rest Residue and Remainder of my personall Estate not herein
 before given and bequeathed my Debts and Legacies being first
 paid and funerall Expences defrayed I give and bequeath the same
 unto my very good friend Christopher Wooden of Deptford ^{and his heirs}
 his Executors Administrators and Assignes for ever And I doe
 hereby nominate and appoint the said Christopher Wooden full
 and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament revoking
 all former and other Wills Testaments Bequests or Deeds of
 Gift by me at any time heretofore made and this is to be taken
 as and for my only last Will and Testament In Witnes whereof
 I have herewith set my hand and seale the eighteenth day
 of October Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and
 seven And in the sixth year of the Raigne of our Sovereigne
 Lady Ann by the grace of God of Great Brittainne France and
 Ireland Queen or Edward Rippington signed sealed published
 and declared by the Testator Edward Rippington to be his last
 Will and Testament in the presence of us Tho: Brooker Marye
 Brooker Tho: Wellings Notary Publit in King Street
 Deptford.
