

In the Name of God Amen I William Rippington coachman to Henry Michael Evans of Hertford Street Mayfair in the county of Middlesex Esquire not being well in Bodily Health but of sound and disposing Mind Memory and understanding praised be God do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say) first and principally I surrender up my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God my Creator hoping to be saved by and through the only merits and satisfaction of Jesus Christ my Saviour and Redeemer and my Body I commit to the Earth to be decently interred and buried by and at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named and as for such worldly Effects as it hath pleased God to bless me with after payment of a certain Debts Legacy and Expences of my funeral I Give and Dispose thereof in manner herein after mentioned whereas I am indebted to Sarah Fussell now living with Mr Coventry Buckley in Dove Street near Berkeley Square the Sum of Seventeen Pounds which I desire my Executors will pay as soon as conveniently they can after my decease and whereas I have three different Boxes near Uxbridge in the Country House of my said Master Henry Michael Evans containing my wearing Apparel fourteen Guineas and a Bank Stock Note for sixty Pounds according to the price of which is therein vested at three per centum per annum out of which I desire the above mentioned Debts of seventeen Pounds to be paid I likewise give and bequeath to the said Sarah Fussell the Sum of ten pounds for her sole and separate use to be also paid as soon as conveniently after my decease I also give and bequeath my watch and one pair of Silver shoe Buckles to my Brother Joseph Rippington now living with Robert Palk Esquire in Bruton Street Berkeley Square I also give and bequeath to my other Brother Samuel Rippington now living with Mr..... Merchant at the Bridge foot Lewes in the County of Sussex one pair of Silver Shoe Buckles and as to all the remainder of the said Sum of sixty Pounds in the Stock as aforesaid after payment of the before mentioned Debt and Legacy to the said Sarah Fussell together with all my Boxes wearing Apparel and what other Effects I may be possessed of at the time of my decease I give and bequeath to my said two Brothers to be divided between them equal share and share alike and lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said Brothers Joseph Rippington and Samuel Rippington Executors of this my Will hereby revoking and making void all former and other wills or Testamentary dispositions by me at any time heretofore made and declare this only will and Testament In Witness whereof I the said William Rippington the Testator have to this my last will and Testament set my hand and Seal the twenty second day of July one thousand seven hundred and seventy eight William Rippington
